# 2022 - A Year to Give Back and Give Thanks

The beginning of 2022 was a roller coaster of emotions caused by the relief of a COVID vaccine, contrasted with an endless number of COVID variants, resulting in repeated restrictions and closures.

Despite COVID's persistent ability to force us to adjust, adapt and change it did not stop the spread of cancer.

COVID sent our health care system into a crisis, exhausting healthcare workers as well as caregivers of cancer patients who have felt the impact of COVID as acutely as the patient themselves. The inability to attend cancer treatments due to COVID protocols; early release to home for a variety of reasons and delayed surgeries or treatments have forced family members and friends to take on care responsibilities, causing higher stress levels and anxiety than ever before.

The Cancer Assistance Program's (CAP) role since inception 28 years ago has been to provide FREE practical services to cancer patients and their families and to help alleviate the financial burden a diagnosis brings.

In 2021 CAP services saved cancer patients and their families over \$676,000. Considering the financial challenges that a cancer diagnosis brings and the increased financial implications that COVID has created, CAP is meeting an unprecedented need in our community.

It takes a dedicated team of staff and volunteers as well as generous and committed donors to dig a little deeper to help meet the increasing need for our services. Every dollar raised, every hour donated, and every minute spent on delivery of our services is so appreciated by cancer families in our community.

As you read this spring newsletter you will be amazed by the efforts of this committed group who each day try a little harder to provide the very best care and service.

THANK YOU to each of you, who despite a pandemic, continue to ride the roller coaster of life with one common objective – how can we continue to provide "help when it is really needed."








#### Special thanks to our many 2021 GALA DONORS!
